## UPM PRINTING PROCESS WORKSHOP – BEGINNER LEVEL

### **Target Group**

Printing house office personal, merchant customer service people, paper/graphic industry supplier, advertisement agency people, publishing house personnel, print product purchaser, apprentices

### **Content**

- Classroom training about the basics of the offset printing method
- Basic components of the printing press and their functionality (simplified)
- Quality control at the printing press and after the print
- Hands-on training within the CSWO, HSWO or SFO Printing method at the Simulator
- Typical simple printing and paper faults of the process and its handling

Max 8 participants per course, 2 days

## UPM PRINTING PROCESS WORKSHOP – ADVANCED LEVEL

### **Target Group**

Press room manager, quality manager, apprentices in graphic arts, producer, merchant technical service people or paper/graphic industry supplier

### **Requirements**

Basic knowledge about the offset process is required, occasional pressroom experiences will be of help

### **Content**

- Typical printing and paper faults of the process and its handling
- Components of the printing press and their functionality (detailed)
- Introduction to the Simulator usage
- Hands-on training within the CSWO, HSWO or SFO Printing method at the Simulator
- Classroom training about specific topics e. g. Trouble shooting, runability, quality control

Max 6 participants per course, 2 days

## UPM PRINTING PROCESS WORKSHOP – SYSTEMATIC PROBLEM SOLVING

### **Target Group**

Printer, press room manager, quality manager, apprentices in printing, merchant technical service people or graphic industry supplier

### **Requirements**

Good knowledge about the offset process is required, printing experience will be of help

### **Content**

- Typical printing and paper faults of the process and its reasons in detail
- Introduction to the Simulator usage
- Hands-on training within the CSWO, HSWO or SFO Printing method at the Simulator
- Trouble shooting practicing at the simulator (time or cost controlled)
- Classroom training in small groups about specific topics e. g. Trouble shooting techniques, runability, quality control
